To Acoustical Surfaces:

Hey this stuff is great! This was my second home theater I've built for myself. The first time I built and needed acoustics I decided I would build panels and mount them to the walls, and that did a pretty good job and looked great, but took a lot of time and labor.

These pictures show the Wallmate™ track as well as the Echo Eliminator® acoustical cotton core as they are being installed. The tension of the fabric is pulled in all directions and stands slightly off the cotton to hide any seams between the acoustical panels. Ideally, we try to supply the cotton core as close to the color of fabric as possible.
